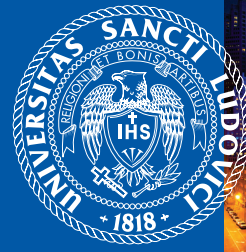

❖ **Personal Statement of Interest**

Offer insight into your background, describing your interest in pursuing an advanced law degree and any particular interest in SLU LAW.

❖ **Current Resume**

❖ **Statement of Scholarship Qualification**
