## FINANCIAL AID RESOURCES

### Dean's Tuition Fellowship Awards

- **About:** highly selective and limited awards that are granted on the basis of need and merit, that typically amount to 20% to 30% of the total cost of tuition
- **Eligibility:** all applicants are automatically eligible for consideration; applicants to the LL.M. program must hold a first law degree from the U.S. or abroad prior to commencing their coursework in August in order to be eligible for admission
- **Requirements:** no application is necessary; applicants may provide any additional details that they believe may be compelling for consideration by the Graduate Studies Committee in the "Finances" section of the online application; grantees will be notified by the LL.M. Program after receiving their offer of admission; **apply** online to the LL.M. Program by **February 15, 2018**

### Law Library Research Assistant Paid Positions

- **About:** on occasion, the law school will hire student Research Assistants to support law professors on their research needs; Research Assistants typically work 10 hours per week, and are trained and supervised by law reference librarians while providing research assistance for faculty projects
- **Eligibility:** successful candidates must demonstrate academic excellence and research proficiency, in addition to strong interpersonal and communication skills; some faculty projects may require additional substantive, technical, or language skills
- **Requirements:** the number of available positions depends on faculty needs, and as a result, frequently varies from year to year; in some years, there may be no open positions; students may submit applications after the start of the academic year in August
